

## Election for the School Council

*Parents !*

*When you elect your representatives*

*for the School Council,*

*you take part in the school's life.*

In a few weeks, as parents, you will have to elect your representatives for the School Council.

### **They play an essential role.**

The School Council is set up for one year. There are regular meetings, and the members give advice, transmit your ideas and your questions on the school's life.

### **Who can vote?**

Every parent can vote. They have only one vote, whatever the number of the children in the same school.

### **Who can run?**

All those who can vote can run.

## To vote

### You have two possibilities:

#### **Vote at the school on the day of the election.**

There is a poll station (you can check the time at the school).

**The postal vote:** in that case, you vote with envelopes which must reach the school through your child before the poll station closes. In order to do this, you must put **ONLY ONE** vote (*you must not write anything on it*) into the small color envelope, which you will get at the school.

*You must not write anything on that envelope either.*

Then you must put it into the larger, white envelope.

At the back of this white envelope, indicate:

your last name, first name

address, and then put your signature.

Each parent (mother and father) can vote.
